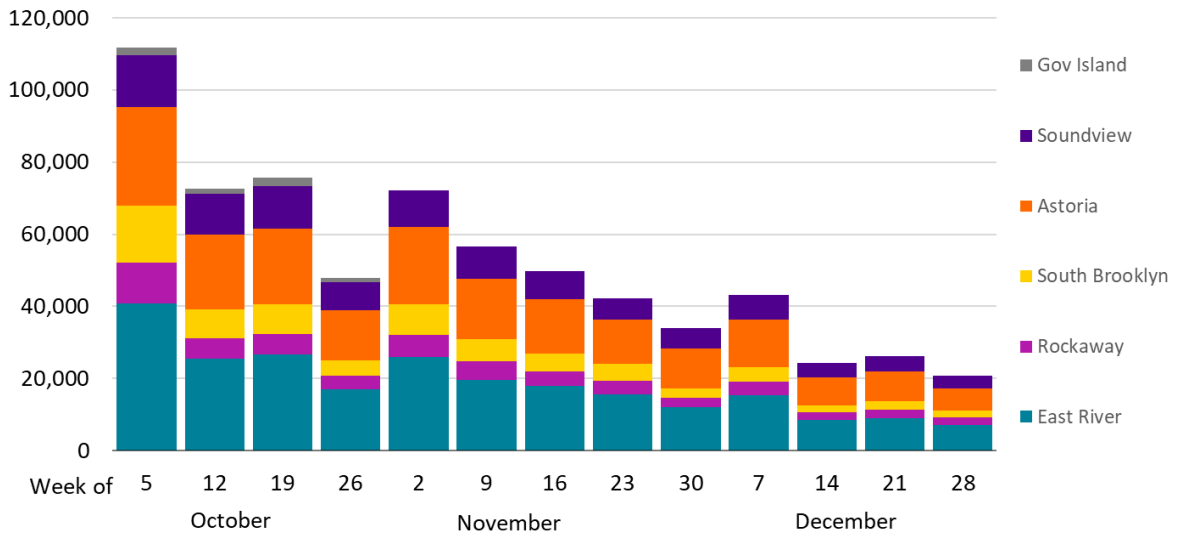

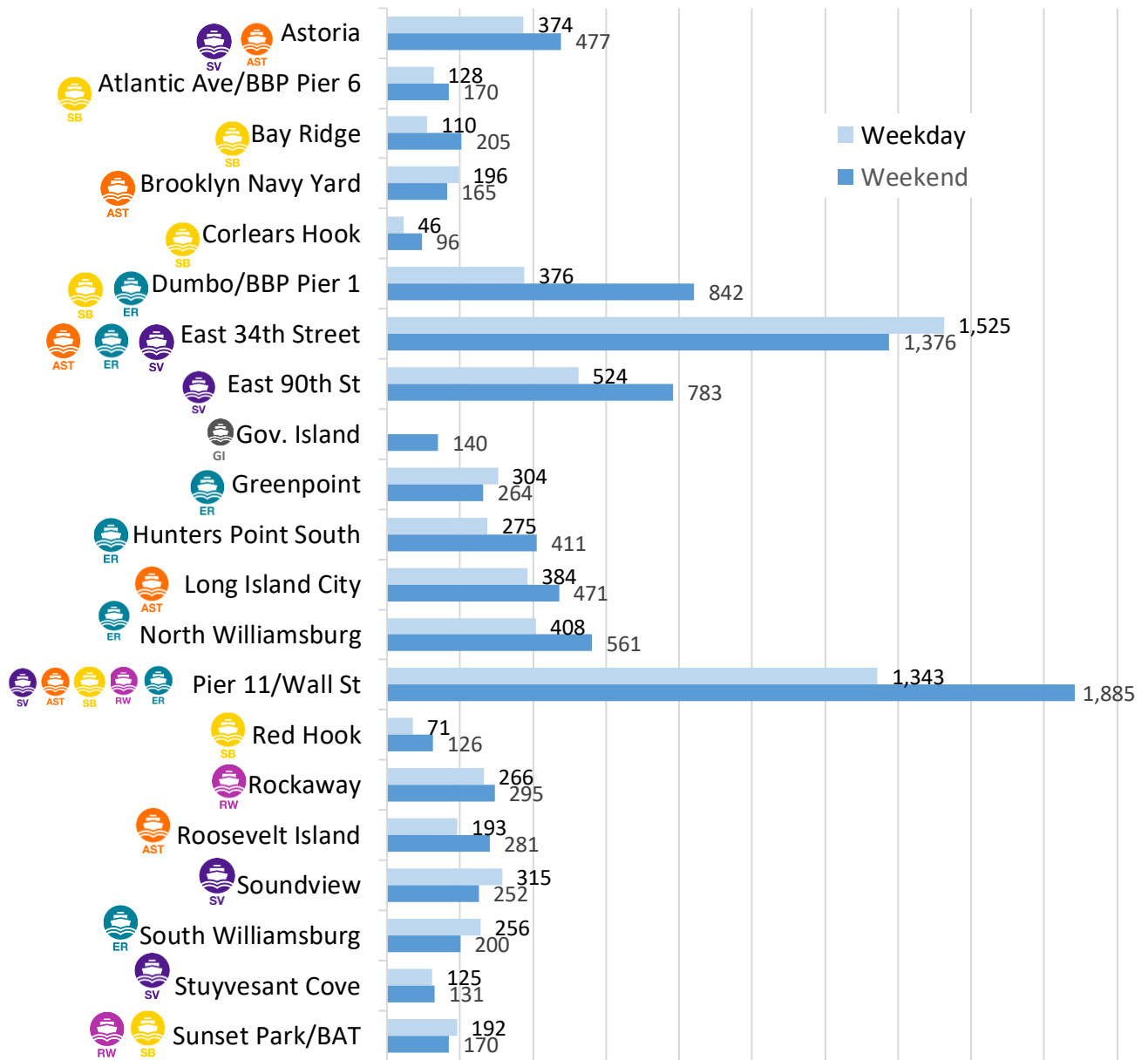

Highlights

Service Notes

The pandemic continues to affect ridership, at 60% of typical levels. The winter schedule resumed on November 2, including a modification in the order of landings on the East River route to reduce travel time to Midtown and improve capacity at Hunters Point South. The 38th vessel arrived in the Harbor in December.

High winds and poor weather conditions caused temporary service suspensions at the Rockaway and Bay Ridge landings in November and December. A severe snowstorm in December caused all ferry and shuttle service to end early with delays occurring the following morning to allow for snow removal.

¹On Time Performance is calculated as the percentage of stops made within the quarter that depart no more than 1 minute before and arrive no more than 5 minutes past their scheduled times. This report includes delays due to events outside of the control of NYC Ferry, such as vessel traffic, river closures/obstructions, extreme weather conditions, and other U.S. Coast Guard restrictions. When tracking devices are offline, the stops are excluded from the calculation. ²Number of NYCF-branded vessels available for use. ³The LES route was reconfigured in May 2020, with the existing landings moved to other routes. ⁴Governors Island ridership is included in this figure.
